Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Reporting- Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students Section 18004(e) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act

- George T.  - Process: Technical college staff identified recipients from the potential eligible student list provided by the District. Eligible students must complete and submit the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under Section 18004 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Student Affidavit. After submission, the recipient will receive his/her check for the predetermined amount. To that end, said affidavit is posted on the technical college's website with a contact number to reach designated personnel to facilitate process. Funds will be distributed equally to eligible students within the technical college.
